- **Mandatory for high school**

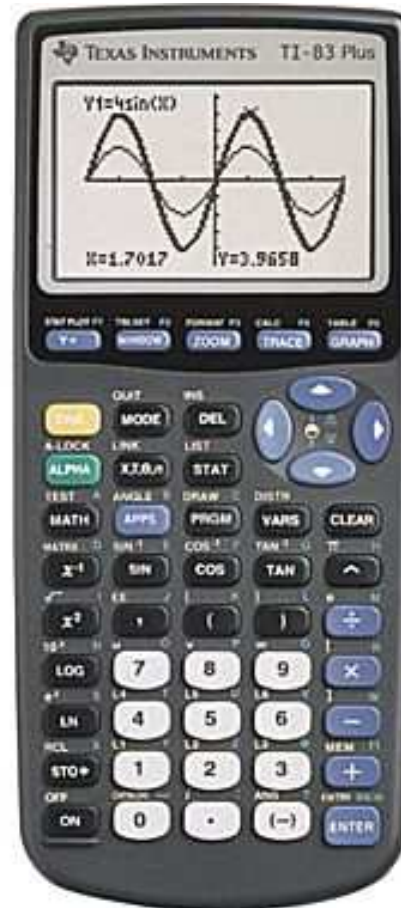
